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This week's SC Kids lesson was "God's Heart For a Lost City", part two of several weeks in the story of Jonah. Use the questions below to review it with your kids.

REVIEW: Jonah 1-4 or Story 69 in *The Gospel Story Bible*; for younger children we recommend reading *"The Jesus Storybook Bible."*

ASK: What were the sins of Nineveh?

People were mean, they stole, lied, and hurt each other's feelings on purpose.

How are your sins like those of Nineveh?

I'm not nice, I don't share very well, I hurt other people's feelings.

What does it mean for God to love unconditionally?

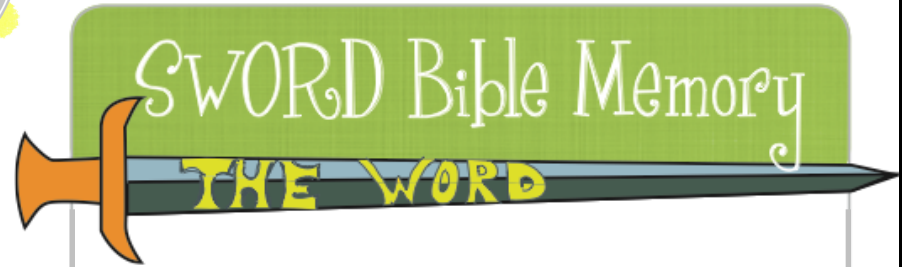
God loves no matter what we do or don't do.
