

A Guide to Family Worship Week of November 2nd, 2014



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This week's SC Kids lesson was "A Sacrifice That Calms the Storm." Use the questions below to review it with your kids.

REVIEW: Jonah 1-4 or Story 69 in *The Gospel Story Bible*; for younger children we recommend reading "*The Jesus Storybook Bible*."

ASK: Why did the big storm happen?

Because Jonah disobeyed and ran from God.

When nothing else stopped the storm, what did Jonah do?

He offered to sacrifice himself and be thrown overboard.

Who else do you know who has sacrificed himself for others?

Jesus.
