

Family Worship Guide Week of February 22, 2015



One of the ways SC Kids partners with parents to make disciples of Jesus is to provide resources that promote discipleship in the home. This Family Worship Guide is intended to give parents content from this week's lesson to discuss with their children throughout the week.

REVIEW

This week's lesson was called "Jesus Cleanses the Temple" and finds its origins in John 2:12-25. For a children's bible version you can refer to Story 86 of the Gospel Story Bible.

DISCUSS

What did Jesus do when the temple turned into a market?

He made a whip, dumped out the boxes of coins, and turned over tables.

How do you think Jesus felt? Why?

He was not happy. He was pretty upset because people turned God's house into a market place.

How many days did Jesus say it would take him to rebuild the temple after it had been destroyed?

Three days.

What was Jesus really talking about?

Jesus is talking about himself. He would be destroyed and then on the third day he would raise from the dead.
