Family Worship Guide Week of March 1, 2015



One of the ways SC Kids partners with parents to make disciples of Jesus is to provide resources that promote discipleship in the home. This Family Worship Guide is intended to give parents content from this week's lesson to discuss with their children throughout the week.

REVIEW

This week's lesson was called "Nicodemus" and comes from John 3:1-21. For a children's bible version you can refer to Story 87 of the Gospel Story Bible.

DISCUSS

Why did Nicodemus come to see Jesus after dark?
He didn't want to be seen by other religious leaders.

What does it mean to be born again?

It means that God's spirit changes our hearts in a way it is like becoming a new person all over again.

What Old Testament story does Jesus tell Nicodemus?

The story of Moses lifting up the bronze snake and everyone who looked at it was healed (Story 42 in the GSB) or Numbers 21:4-9.

How is Jesus like the snake on the pole?

He must be lifted up so that whoever believes in Jesus will have eternal life. Read John 3:16!
