### REVIEW

This week's lesson was called "Good News" and comes from Luke 4:16-44. For a children's bible version you can refer to Story 88 of the Gospel Story Bible.

### DISCUSS

#### **How did Jesus help the woman in the story?**

He healed her from her fever and sickness.

#### **Why did people come to Jesus?**

They wanted Jesus to fix them.

#### **What did Jesus say when people tried to keep him from leaving?**

"I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns as well, for I was sent for this purpose."

#### **If Jesus was physically here today, what would you ask him to do for you?**

### SING

When we experience the grace of God it causes us to sing! As we teach our children about the grace of God we must teach them how to respond to it as well. So as you are discipling your children remember to teach them to sing. Not only is singing an act of worship, but it can be a great way to help you children learn memory verses and big truths about God. ### PRAY

Say something like this to your children to transition into a prayer time: "After seeing Jesus willingly heal so many people, doesn't that make you want to go to Jesus and ask him to fix the broken parts of you? Thankfully, we have a way to do that! It is called prayer. So we are going to thank God for the ways that he has already fixed us and we are going to ask Jesus to fix the parts that still need fixed. What are things that Jesus fix in our lives?" Then model what it looks like to turn to Jesus and experience his healing.

Revisit previous questions with your children to maintain memory retention. Feel free to tailor this to suit your family.
